

The East Fork Lewis River, home to Washington state's record steelhead and one of the last pristine, free-flowing rivers in southwest Washington, is in serious trouble.

Over the last 70 years, largely due to man and nature, the lower 16 miles of the East Fork Lewis River have been severely degraded.

The result — fish-killing, 78° water, warm water predators, destabilized river channel, sedimentation, loss of pools and lack of stable spawning gravel.

Property, facilities and some buildings below Lewisville Park are in jeopardy, the result of unstable channel conditions and related bank erosion.

The river's remaining threatened and endangered wild native salmon and steelhead are in serious trouble.
